The 9th Annual Meetings of the ARMENIAN ECONOMIC ASSOCIATION will be jointly hosted by the Armenian State University of Economics, the Armenian National Agrarian University and the American University of Armenia on 27-29 June, 2019.

Scholars and graduate students are invited to present their research in all areas of economics and finance. Both theoretical and empirical works are welcome. We highly encourage work addressing economic issues in Armenia and the South-Caucasus region.

Please **submit** completed papers or abstracts (of less than 500 words) at <http://aea.am/conferences.html> by 30th April, 2019; decisions will be announced by May 10th. The submission of complete sessions with 3-4 papers is welcome. Students will be offered the opportunity to present posters. There is no submission fee, nor any cost to present and participate.

Best Paper Awards are made available by the AEA for young scholars (Grigor Artzruni award) and for general interest papers (Armen Alchian award), as well as by the International Monetary Fund for papers in macroeconomics and C-quadrat for student papers in pension economics and portfolio management. Submission of completed papers in advance is required to be considered for the awards.
